### Commitment by Company Management

SCHENCK USA CORP. is committed to compliance with all applicable export laws, regulations, and policies of the United States government.

Under no circumstances may an export be made contrary to the applicable laws or regulations of the United States or contrary to the policies mandated under the company's Export Compliance Manual.

Employees outside the United States may not re-export any item, technical data, or software unless appropriate authorization has been obtained.

Failure to comply with these regulations might result in the loss of export privileges, damage to the individual's or the company's reputation, criminal and/or civil fines and penalties, including jail time and monetary penalties, and employees will be subject to disciplinary action and/or termination of employment.


SCHENCK USA CORP. encourages all its employees to identify suspect or questionable transactions that may result in violations of export control laws.


